TRAFFIC ADVISORY

As part of the Red River Floodway Expansion Project, the Manitoba Floodway Authority (MFA) has been undertaking the replacement of the CP Emerson Railway Bridge. As the project nears its final stages, temporary road closures will be required between **June 7, 2009 and October 31, 2009** at the following locations:

- **Closure of Prairie Grove Road between Four Mile Road and Halparin Drive** – Residents are advised to use alternative routes including St. Anne's Road on the west side and PTH 59 South on the east side of the closure on Prairie Grove Road.

Access to Halparin Drive from Prairie Grove Road will be maintained throughout construction while Sioux Road will be inaccessible from Prairie Grove Road between June 27 and August 31

- **Closure of Hallama Drive in the vicinity of CP Emerson Railway Bridge** – Residents are advised to use Old 59 Highway as an alternative route.

Signage will be erected advising the public of the road closures.

MD Steele Construction Ltd. is undertaking the bridge replacement project which will result in the bridge being above the 1-in-700 year flood level. Work on the bridge began last fall and is scheduled for completion this fall.

The MFA would also like to remind the public that work on the floodway expansion project has created an active construction site along the floodway channel. As a result, the public, whether on foot, bicycle, snowmobile, or all-terrain-vehicle, are advised to avoid floodway construction zones.
